

Job Description: K-5 Teachers

Ivy Classical will be accepting K-6 students in Fall 2025 and will continue to grow to K-12 by adding one grade level each year. Each faculty member is a professional who is esteemed and supported by a faculty of colleagues striving for excellence. - Continuously improving instruction and content knowledge through coaching, professional development, and independent study
- Fostering a sense of joy and wonder in the classroom and beyond
- Maintaining high expectations for both academics and behavior through a commitment to schoolwide policies and procedures and the classical model
